BOARD MEETING MINUTES

May 21, 2026

The Suwannee County Conservation District Board of Supervisors held their regularly scheduled meeting Thursday May 21, 2026 at UF/IFAS Suwannee Valley NFREC at 8202 County Road 417 in Live Oak, FL 32060. Supervisors who attended were Andy Jackson; Chairman, James Williams; Secretary/Treasurer, De Broughton; Vice Chair. Also attending were Garrett McCray; SCCD Programs Administrator, Joni Sapp; SCCD Administrative Assistant, Alton Goff; SCCD Conservation Technician, Mallory Jackson; SCCD Conservation Technician, Joel Love; UF/IFAS BMP Research Coordinator, and Ehrin and Emily Beach.

Chairman Jackson called the meeting to order at 12:58pm.

The Minutes of the previous meeting held April 16, 2026 were reviewed. Williams made a motion to approve the minutes, and there was a second by Broughton. Unanimous approval.

Sapp reviewed the Financial Reports. Williams made a motion to approve those reports, and there was a second by Broughton. Unanimous approval.

McCray discussed our cost-share contracts. For BMP Tools, we have 38 contracts totaling \$1,146,459.49. RESTORE Energy has approximately \$920,000 obligated and RESTORE BMP has approximately \$634,000 obligated.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Board and FDACS has chosen and hired Ehrin Beach for the Conservation Technician position with a start date of June 8, 2026.

NEW BUSINESS:

The ordinary bills from Verizon Wireless and Jim Hinton Oil were presented for payment. Williams made a motion to approve, and there was a second by Broughton. Unanimous approval.
