BOARD MEETING MINUTES

August 20, 2026

The Suwannee County Conservation District Board of Supervisors held their regularly scheduled meeting Thursday August 20, 2026 at The USDA Service Center located at 1525-B Ohio Avenue South in Live Oak, FL 32064. Supervisors who attended were De Broughton; Vice Chair, James Williams; Secretary/Treasurer, Wesley Wainwright; Supervisor, and Larry Sessions; Supervisor. Also attending were Garrett McCray; SCCD Programs Administrator, Joni Sapp; SCCD Administrative Assistant, Alton Goff; Conservation Technician, Ehrin Beach; Conservation Technician, and Raymond Barbosa; UF/IFAS Extension Agent.

Broughton called the meeting to order at 7:08pm.

The Minutes of the previous meeting held July 16, 2026 were reviewed. Williams made a motion to approve the minutes, and there was a second by Sessions. Unanimous approval.

Sapp reviewed the Financials. Williams made a motion to approve those reports, and there was a second by Sessions. Unanimous approval.

McCray discussed our cost-share contracts. For BMP Tools, we have 24 approved contracts with approximately \$260,000 remaining to be obligated. RESTORE Energy has approximately \$189,000 remaining to obligate and RESTORE BMP has approximately \$500,000 remaining to obligate.
